## I-READING COMPREHENSION

### A- The text

- 1- In 2004, Tomas Belon was separated from his family for two days after a tsunami wave hit Thailand beaches. Now, 17, he is studying at Atlantic College in Great Britain. Tomas, from Spain, chose that college partly because of its lifeguard training programme. Besides, it is a residential college which brings together students from around the world.
- 2- Tomas' desire to help others comes after his family's experience on the 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2004. Tomas, his father, mother and brothers Simon, 5, and Lucas, 10, were staying at the Orchid Resort Hotel in the Khao Lak region of Thailand. Tomas, his father and Simon were in the swimming pool playing with a ball when the disaster hit. Mrs. Belon was watching as Lucas got out of the water to fetch the ball when they heard the roar of the 9-metre wave. When she resurfaced, Mrs. Belon and Lucas took refuge up a tree until being taken to hospital by a stranger.
- 3- Tomas and Simon were left stuck on the roof for hours until they heard the lifeguards calling them. It was two days before the entire family was reunited. Mrs. Belon spent more than a year being treated in hospitals in Singapore and Spain following a life-saving operation to repair injuries to her legs and chest. The story was told in last year's film, The Impossible.
- 4- Tomas said it was not just a story about his family but about all the families that had been affected. "The script was co-written by my mother. It stays true to what happened and it tells the story of the 300,000 people who died. We were lucky enough to survive."
